*Wayfarers Tennis Club - Revised Measures for Play*

---

- **Important:** Do not leave your home to play tennis if Government advice means you should stay at home because you or someone you live with has or has had symptoms of COVID-19, or you are in the most vulnerable category and have been advised to shield from the virus.
- There will be no organized tennis sessions until further notice e.g. Wednesday evening or Saturday afternoon socials.
- For the time being, you **MUST** still notify the Chairman in advance - either by text or email\* - stating who will be playing and when. This is so that use of the courts can be monitored to avoid any potential overcrowding.

- If you have not already renewed your Club membership please contact Jane\* to arrange payment before you organise any matches. \* Jane: 07516 928857
- **Doubles play is now permitted** with people from outside of your household as long as you remain 2 metres apart as far as possible - meaning that four people from different households can now play doubles.
- **Players do not now need to use their own clearly marked tennis balls** but if you use shared balls then extra care must be taken to ensure that you do not touch your face during play and you should sanitise your hands before and before and after your game.
- You must adhere to the Government's social distancing guidelines and stay at least 2 meters away from others at all times. You must not make physical contact with other players such as shaking hands.
- Please bring a full bottle of water to avoid the need to touch the outside water tap.
- Please take your own hand sanitizer on court with you and use it frequently. Clean and wipe down your equipment - including your racket and water bottle - before and after use.
- As far as is possible, please avoid touching the gates, benches and net winders etc. Please sanitise any surface that you do touch.
- A one-way system on and off the courts has been temporarily introduced. Please enter via the gates nearest the Clubhouse and exit via the furthest gates. When changing ends please do so to your right hand side of the net.
- Carefully arranged and managed social activity can take place for groups of no more than 6 people, subject to social distancing always being in place.
- You should assume that the Clubhouse will be closed. However, if the Clubhouse is open then use of the toilets is permitted but you must take extra care and wash your hands thoroughly after use. You may also turn on the floodlights but you must not use any other facilities including the bar, gym, showers or kitchen area.
